1. Title of the Practice

Scholarship Scheme For Socially And Economically Backward Students.

2. Objectives of the Practice

The College Management and faculty members have nurtured a dream to impart free education to their students both at the undergraduate and post graduate levels and empower them in order to mitigate the gender inequality prevailing in the society. In fostering the academic growth and all-round development of the students Institution has instituted free-ship scheme besides the schemes offered by the government. The alumni association will also contribute to the needy students with their project expenses, training program and providing books and guidance. The objective is to waive who are needy as well as meritorious. The scheme motherly takes care of the educational needs of students both at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

3. The Context

The disbursement of scholarships or granting of fee waivers or free-ship schemes to the selected students is based on the amount, The decision regarding the branch in which it would be given and setting up of eligibility criteria for application by students, their identification, selection and verification of genuine applicants are the challenging issues faced in the implementation of the practice.

The students were lacking the confidence and the skills to take up various competitive examination due to the inability to join coaching institutes as it would mean extra strain on financial resources. In view of the same the institution took up the onus of providing free coaching to them.

4. The Practice

In the memory of late NAWAB SHAH ALAM KHAN founding chairman initiated freeship for deserving students. To realize this aim the Aizza Group of Society- the founding body of the College, The facility is extended to needy, meritorious and differently abled students in consonance with the Mission of the College of raising the level of education of students belonging to the lower and middle sections of the society as well as the minority class so as to help them realize their goals, become self-reliant, economically independent and carve a niche for themselves in the society.

A notice inviting the notice inviting application from prospective students is put up on the College notice board. After the receipt of applications, the deserving students are identified and called for an interview before the freeship Committee. The Committee decides upon the list of

selected students on the basis of their merit and the genuineness of their need as well. Finally, the list of selected candidates is notified on the Notice board and students are telephonically informed in person. The scholarship amount is remitted into their fee account. This message is communicated among the larger students about this facility and motivates them to continue making efforts in the academic field even if they face economic challenges in the home. The institution will provide the financial support for their educational needs.

Freeship is when the total tuition fee is paid by the authority which is sponsoring it for the time period which they have approved. Some offer Freeship where they waive off the tuition fee, however, the student has to pay for the accommodation and food expenses.

A **freeship** is a form of financial aid awarded to the candidates, Scholarships are awarded based upon various criteria, such as academic merit, athletic skill, and financial need. Institutions provide complete support to the selected candidates in every department when it comes to their financial crisis, they need not to pay single penny, these freeship a college or awards to selected candidates is career specific who plan to pursue a specific field of study. The freeship for which applicants can initially qualify not based upon gender, race, religion, caste etc

5. Evidence of Success

The college initiative for giving free scholarship to socially and economically backward students by MADARSA-I-AIZZA Society each year, increased expanse of the scholarships have registered an increase in the number of beneficiaries. The under privilege and deserving students are among the beneficiaries. Many of the beneficiaries have been able to continue higher studies despite all odds at home specifically at the financial front.

The increasing number of students getting registered and participation every year in the Institution is highly motivating. It has also been observed that the students are highly motivated and presenting themselves in the best possible way to show that the college has taken right decision by giving them admission and showing faith on them based on the merit

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

Sometimes the entire process right from issue of notification and then inviting applications followed by doing background check of each individuals and then heading to final selection of beneficiaries takes a long period. It has also been noticed that due to delay by the students in submitting the filled up applications due to which also noticed that the amount of scholarship is made available at the end of the session, it will generally a while to encounter the problem and give the expected result much beyond the time of requirement.
