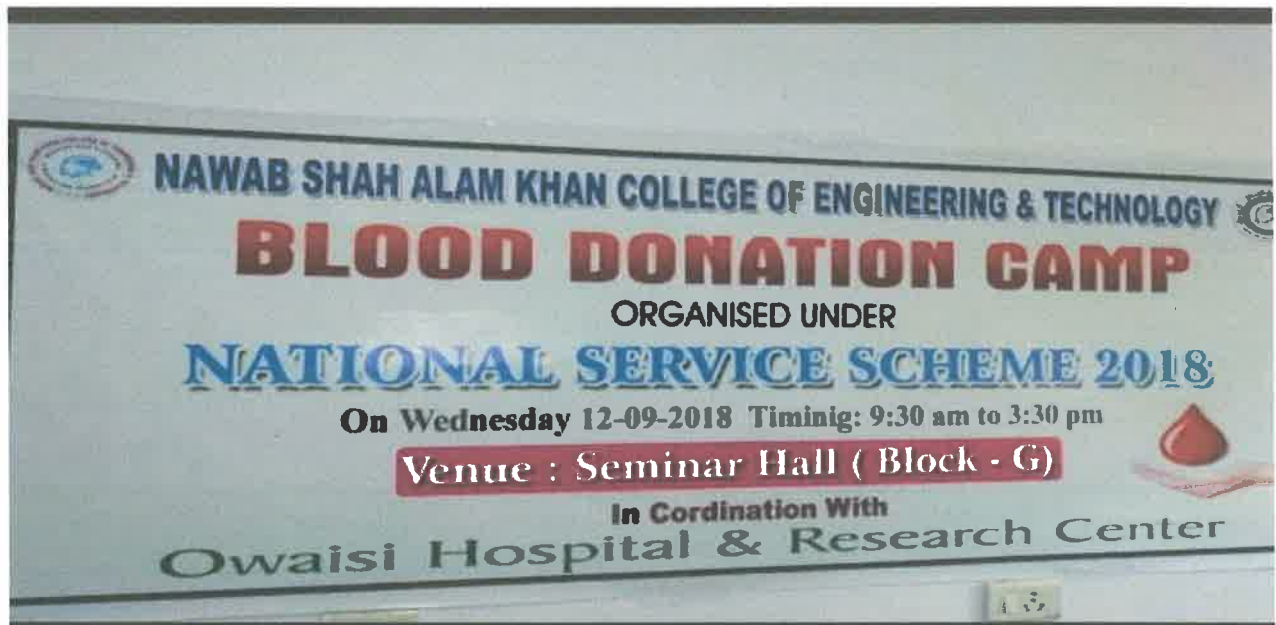
### **Anti-Drug Awareness Program:**


