Through the reference 1st cited, the Government of Telangana has accorded permission to the Minority Educational Institutions for change of affiliation from one University to another University. Accordingly, Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology, New Malakpet, Hyderabad (a Minority Institution) has been permitted for change of affiliation from JNTUH to Osmania University from the academic year 2019-2020 as per guidelines stipulated by the Osmania University.

Based on the approval of the AICTE and on the recommendation of the University Inspection Committee, sanction is hereby accorded for grant of extension of provisional affiliation to **Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology**, New Malakpet, Hyderabad for the academic year **2019-2020** to offer the following Engineering Courses with the intake mentioned against each:

Note: Sanctioned students intake shall be considered for all (4) years in respect of UG Courses and (2) Years in respect of PG Courses for calculating Teacher: Student Ratio.


